Recognizing an Opioid Overdose



When a person overdoses, breathing will slow dangerously and may stop altogether, eventually leading to brain damage or death.



**Slow heartbeat or
low blood pressure**



**Slow, irregular, or
stopped breathing**



Pale, clammy skin
